SCHOOL IS COOL

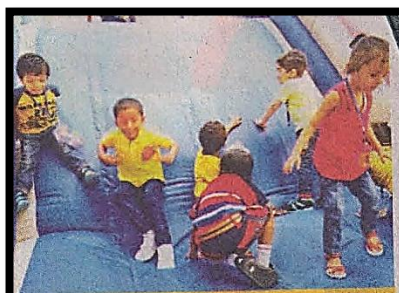
New team of captains and leaders
